# Installing WordPress In 10 Steps

### **Please Note: Before using this guide you must have:**

A – The guide is based on having access to GVO web-hosting tools. If you do not have an account with GVO it is easy to get one just [CLICK HERE](#) and then find the package that works best for you.


B – You will need to have already registered your Website Name [Domain Name] – this usually costs around 10 dollars a year. If you need to register/purchase your Website Name just [CLICK HERE](#).

C – The Nameservers for your Website [Domain Name Servers = DNS] need to point to GVO [web-host] this can be done when purchasing your Domain Name or changed after but Websites need to point to the Webhost. Log into your GVO account and follow the instructions for Step 2. Changing Your DNS. [this process may take 5 minutes or 48 hours].

**Step 1 – Log in to GVO and click on Web Host Manager.**

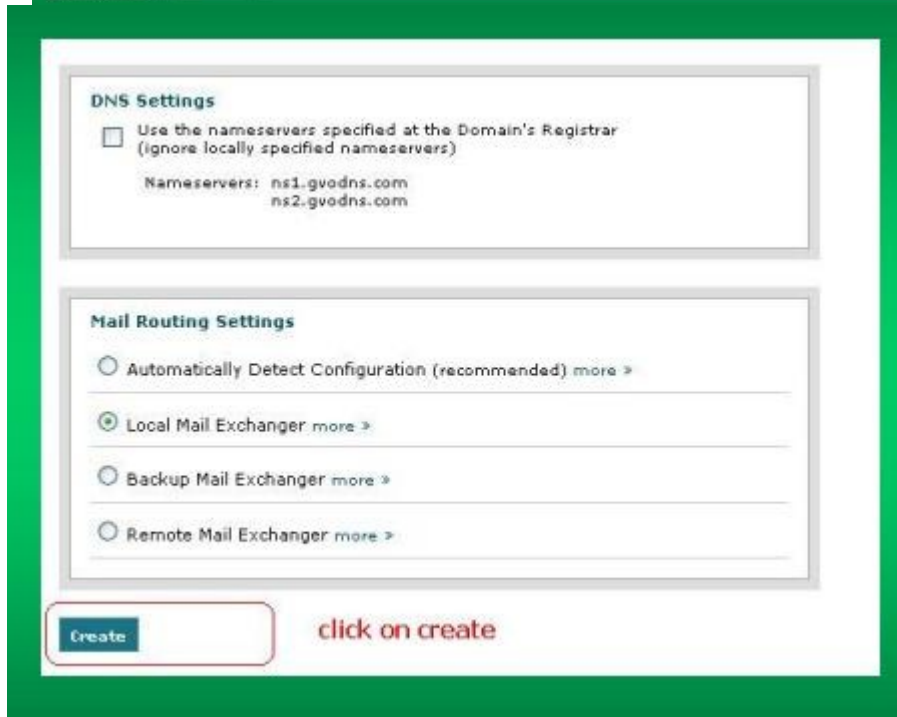
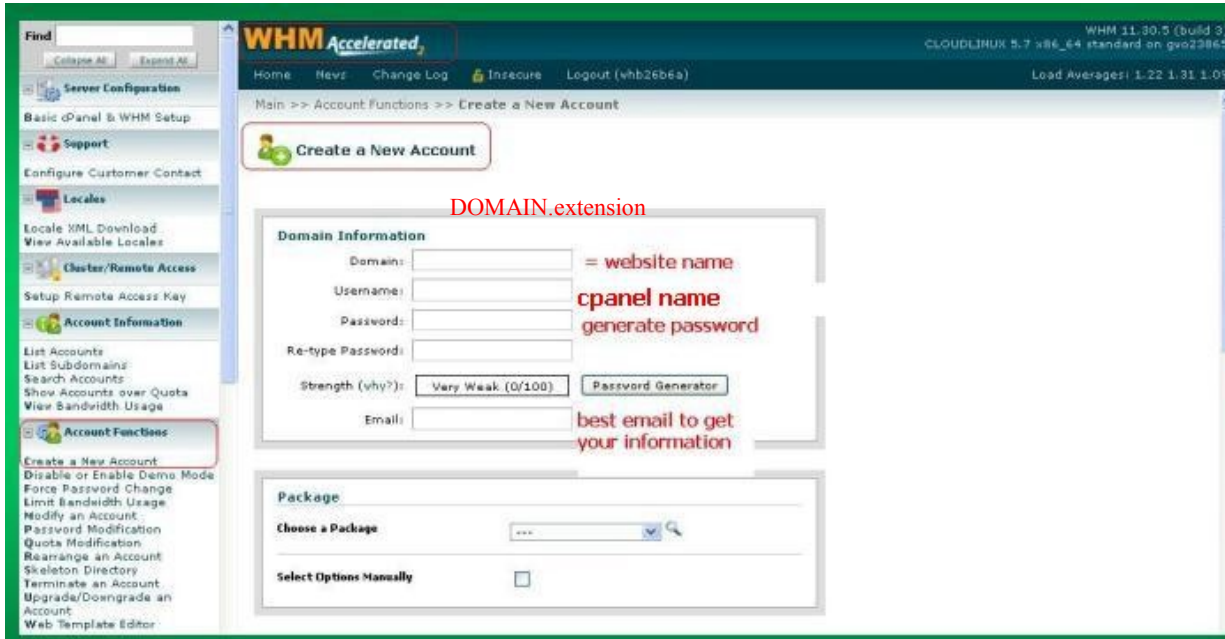


**Step 2 – On the GVO web page watch the video for more details on how to setup your site or click on the blue bar to access your web host manager. [WHM].**

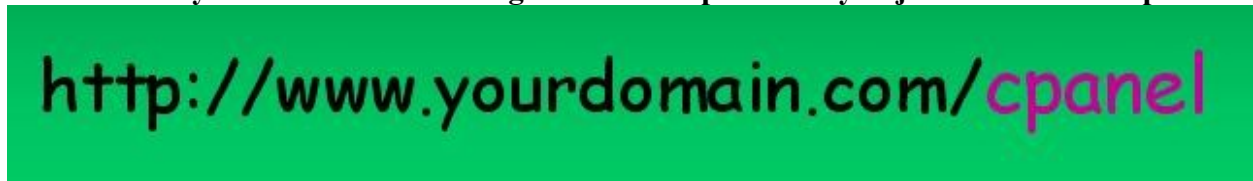
**Step 3 – In WHM [Web Host Manager] create a New Account – this information becomes the CPANEL log in name and password for your website. Choose a simple name, generate a password, put in the email you use most and then Click on Create.**



**Step 4 – The creation process takes a few minutes, when the process is done copy the information and put in a notepad just-in-case. This information will also be sent to the email you listed in Step 3.**



**Step 5- Log out of WHM & GVO. Put Your website name followed by /cpanel in your browser. Your website may be a .net or .info or .ws so make sure to use the correct dot extension for your website and the login name and password you just created in Step 4.**



**Step 6 – Click on Fantastico De Luxe.**



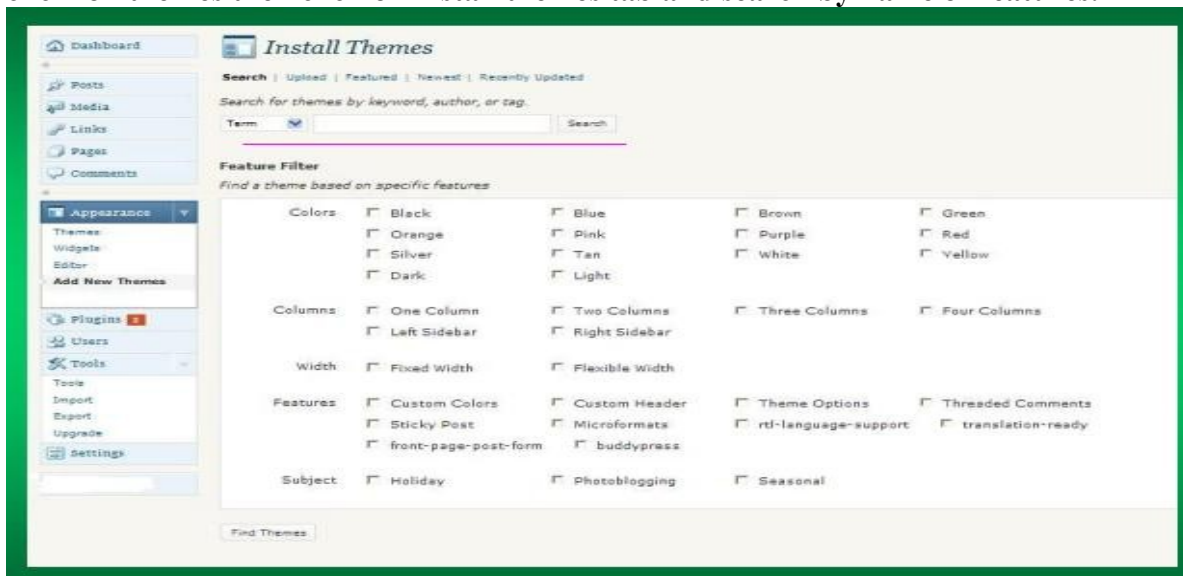
**Step 7 – Click on Wordpress – chose the name & password login you will use for Wordpress access. Do not use admin, write down and save this information.**



**Step 8 – Once the installation is complete log out of cpanel and put your website name/wp-admin/ in the browser and log in with the name and password you chose in Step 7.**



**Step 9 – Find a theme for your website. In the left hand column click on Appearance then click on themes then click on install themes tab and search by name or features.**



**Step 10 – Install a theme and take a look, you can test several and use the one you like best. You may want to check that your theme has columns, footer and/or options you like. You might install one then change later but it is often easier to change themes during the first phase of website setup.**

**Search for the name of the plugin – All in One SEO.**

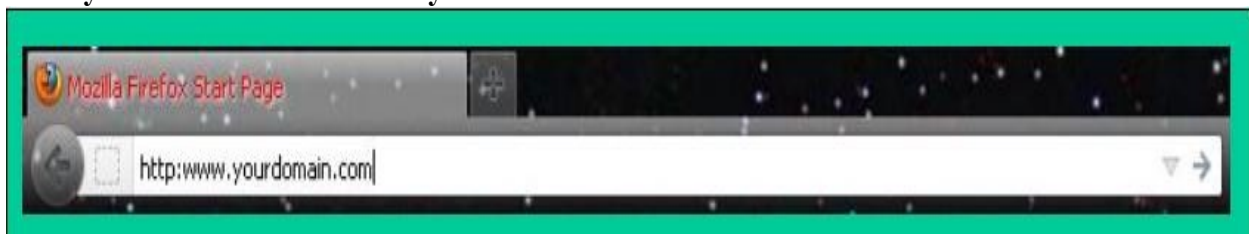




**Click on Install Now and then activate the plugin .**
